BRAZIL

The ICAC and the Commission Against Corruption of Macao joined forces to share their anti-corruption experience in Brazil. The 3-day “Capacity Building Programme for the Office of the Comptroller General of the Union, Brazil” (24-26 Mar) gathered over 80 officials from local anti-graft and law enforcement agencies.



HUNGARY

The ICAC conducted Anti-Corruption Training for 60 graft fighters of Hungarian Integrity Authority in Budapest (27 May-3 Jun), focusing on corruption investigation techniques, corruption prevention strategies, community education and anti-graft publicity approaches.



THAILAND

With the support of the Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission of Thailand, the ICAC and the Hong Kong Police Force conducted trainings at the International Anti-corruption Capacity Building Programme for over 150 graft fighters and the Royal Thai Police (26-28 May). 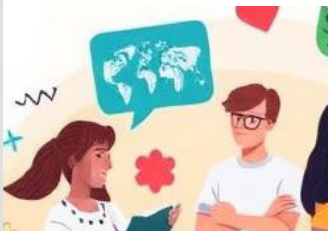
